While flying as an observer with the 8th Air Force, then Colonel Spivey was shot down over the Ruhr valley on 12 August 1943 and taken POW. He was the senior American officer in the north camp of Stalag Luft III. He commanded several Air Force commands from 1945 until retirement in 1956. From 1956 until 1967, he was the Commandant of the Culver Military Academy.
