Elwin (Dick) Schrupp was a B-25 pilot in the 310th Bomb Group based in Algeria in World War II. On 12 March 1943 his aircraft was shot down while bombing an Axis convoy in the Mediterranean. He was taken prisoner by Germans and was sent to Stalag Luft III where he performed vital services by virtue of being fluent in German. He was a dedicated leader in the post-war Stalag Luft III Former POW Association.
