MAJOR GENERAL JARRED V. CRABB
United States Air Force
1902 - 1981

Beginning with an Air Corps Reserve commission in 1930, General Crabb had a distinguished career in WWII combat as a bomb group commander and successive commands of the 5th, 9th, 13th Air Forces, HQ Air Defense Command and in the National War College. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and was twice awarded the Distinguished Service Medal (in 1945 and '52) and the Legion of Merit (in 1945 and '58). He was a Dr. of Laws (honorary) conferred by Purdue University in 1953.
