**EDWARD D. "BO" SHAW**

**Lieutenant, U. S. Army Air Forces**

As a P-38 pilot in the 27th Ftr Sqn, 1st Ftr Gp, in the MTO during WWII, Lt. Shaw was credited with 3 enemy aircraft destroyed. On 5 June 1943 when returning from a bombing mission at Cagliari, Sardinia, he was shot down over the Mediterranean and imprisoned in Germany at Stalag Luft III until liberated by the U. S. Army on 29 April 1945.
