The Clark B-17 Crew of the 366th Squadron 305th Bomb Group shot down in "Madame Butterfly" over Kiel, Germany 19 May 1943 on its 19th Mission. The Crew ditched once in the Atlantic in October 1942, was on the first mission to Germany in January 1943, and lead the squadron to bomb the Billancourt Renault Tank Factory Paris, France on 4 April 1943, for which the Group received a unit citation.
