Richard Topper was a civilian Supervisory Military Personnel Management Specialist at HQ USAF from 1954 to 1970. His early work produced enabling legislation for the then nascent Air Force Academy. Later, as Chief of the AFA Appointment Branch, he composed the initial regulations and procedures for Presidential and other appointments to the Academy. Among other innovative programs, he first established service academy briefings for new members of Congress. Upon his retirement in 1970 he was awarded the Decoration for Exceptional Civilian Service by the Secretary of the Air Force.
