Thomas Mulligan's aircraft was shot down 12 August 1944 on his 25th mission and he became a POW in Center Compound, Stalag Luft III. In the January '45 exodus of the camp he, at great peril, carried out the covert POW records of the Camp's history which became the impetus for Durand's book, Stalag Luft III, The Secret Story. He was awarded the Bronze Star and Air Medal. He received a commendation from General Spivey.
