Californian "Jack" Fessler was training to be an airline pilot in 1940 when he joined the Royal Air Force. Upon arrival in England, he was assigned to the first of the three American Eagle Squadrons, Number 71, flying RAF Hurricanes and Spitfires in combat. He was shot down in October 1941 over France and became a POW in Stalag Luft III. He was liberated on 29 April 1945. Following World War II, he had a distinguished career as a pilot with United Air Lines.
