EWELL ROSS MCCRIGHT **Lieutenant, U. S. Army Air Forces** **1915 -- 1990**

Ewell McCright was a bombardier in the 303rd Bomb Group and shot down over France on 23 January 1943. He was imprisoned at Stalag Luft III where an American officer assigned him the task of keeping a record of all American POWs. He kept ledgers with this record hidden from the Germans, under threat of death if discovered. He carried these ledgers on the forced marches in January/February 1945 westward to Mooseberg where he was liberated 29 April 1945.
