Edwin Rawlings graduated from Hamline University with a degree in Economics in 1927. He was commissioned in the Army Air Corps as a 2nd Lieutenant and rated pilot in 1930. He graduated from the Harvard Graduate School of Business with honors in 1939. From 1951 until his retirement, Edwin Rawlings commanded the Air Materiel Command. In 1954 he was promoted to General. He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Soldier's medal for outstanding performance in two separate air accidents. He was awarded the William E. Mitchell Award, the Distinguished Service Medal and several foreign decorations. Rawlings retired from the Air Force in 1959 and joined the General Mills Corporation. In 1961 he was appointed Executive Vice President and retired from General Mills in 1969.
