WILLIAM BYINGTON WYNN

LT. COLONEL, U. S. ARMY AIR CORPS

1893 - 1943

Wynn was commissioned in the Infantry in 1916. He began duty with the Aviation Section, Signal Corps in 1917. During 1918 - 1919, he was the Commanding Officer of the 168th Aero Squadron and the 2d Army Air Observation Group. He also served as the Air Attache to France. Promoted to Lt. Colonel, U. S. Army Air Service in 1920, he was awarded the Silver Star and the Distinguished Service Cross. He retired in 1927 and became the Chief Instructor, Curtis Wright Flying Service, Houston, Texas in 1929 - 1930.
