Lt. Colonel James "Mac" MacWilliam enlisted in the Army Air Corps in August, 1941 and earned his pilot wings as a Staff Sergeant in July, 1942. As with other Staff Sergeant Pilots, he was promoted to Warrant Officer late in 1942 and then to First Lieutenant in 1943. He saw service first with the 22nd Bombardment Group and then with the 345th Bombardment Group in New Guinea. He retired in 1964. He was one of the founders of the Army Air Corps Enlisted Pilots Association.
