Jarred V. Crabb was born in Olney, Illinois. He graduated from Purdue University and was commissioned Second Lieutenant in the Army Air Corps in 1930. In 1942 he was named Commander of the 345th Bomb Group which was assigned to the Southwest Pacific Theater and later Commander of the 5th Air Force Bomber Command. In 1958 he was appointed Chief of Staff, Air Defense Command. He was twice awarded the Distinguished Service Medal, Legion of Merit and Distinguished Flying Cross. Purdue University awarded him an Honorary LL.D degree in 1953.
