GEORGE CHURCHILL KENNEY

GENERAL, USAF (RET)

1889 - 1972

Enlisted in 1917 in the Aviation Section of the Signal Corps. He flew 12 combat missions with the 91st Aero. Squadron and downed 2 enemy aircraft. In the U.S. Army Air Corps in the 1930s, he had several command positions and was an Assistant Air Attaché in Paris. In WWII, he was the Commanding General of Allied Air Forces in the Southwest Pacific, Commander of the 5th Air Force and the Pacific Air Command. Later he was the first Commander of the Strategic Air Command. He commanded the Air University until his retirement in 1951. His awards included the Distinguished Service Cross and Medal, Silver star and the Distinguished Flying Cross. He received an LL.D Degree from Notre Dame University.

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
