Kenneth Kurtenbach became a POW in Germany in WW II in December 1942. Because of his outstanding leadership he was elected by his 4200 fellow prisoners as their Man of Confidence to represent them in all matters with the German authorities. He led these men with great courage and good judgment through many crises involving starvation, brutality and forced marches until they were liberated by U. S. Army forces in Austria in May, 1945.
