Irons joined the Army Air Corps as a flight trainee. He graduated as a 2d lieutenant in the class of 43-A. He served in the Allied Mediterranean Photo Reconnaissance Wing and flew 200 combat missions in the RP-38 aircraft. He photographed the results of the August 17, 1943 raid on Regensburg. In September, 1944, as a major, he commanded the 32d Photo Recce. Squadron in Italy. He later served in Vietnam and on tours with the U. S. Navy and the Royal Air Force. He was awarded the Silver Star, the Bronze Star, and the Distinguished Flying Cross among other decorations. He retired in 1968 and died in 1996.
