ROBERT LEROY CARLBERG

FIRST LIEUTENANT, U. S. ARMY AIR FORCES

Bob Carlberg was born December 12, 1919 and joined the U. S. Army from Pender, Nebraska. He was a bomber pilot in World War II and was shot down in combat on October 21, 1942 near Brest, France. After ditching the aircraft successfully, he was captured by the Germans and remained a prisoner of war in Stalag Luft III at Sagan, Silesia and Stalag VIIA, Bavaria until liberated on April 29, 1945. His move between these two camps was by forced march in severe winter weather. Doctor Carlberg died March 13, 1989..
